Inspect holiday lights for frayed wires, broken sockets or other signs of wear.

Avoid connecting more than three strings of lights together.

For outdoor decorating, use only lights and power strips that are approved for outdoor use.

Colorado Governor Polis Joins Tri-State to Announce Greenhouse Gas Reduction Goals

Last month, SMPA's wholesale power provider, Tri-State Generation and Transmission Association (Tri-State) and Colorado Gov. Jared Polis announced Tri-State will be submitting, to the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) a "preferred scenario" to reduce emissions associated with its wholesale electricity sales in Colorado by 80% by 2030.

Why did you sign up to receive outage notifications from San Miguel Power?

San Miguel Power's outage notification system is a great tool. Tri-County Water has 29 pump stations that are needed to deliver water uphill to our Ouray County customers. These pump stations are powered by SMPA. If the power is flowing, our water is flowing. The outage notification system helps TCW do our job more efficiently.

Were you satisfied with the notifications you received? Yes, we are very satisfied. We are informed immediately 24/7.

How do you expect the outage notification system will help you in case of future power outages? The outage notification system is a part of our daily monitoring of the operations of our water system. It will shorten the time our customers experience low pressure and outages.

You don't have to be a public service to receive these notifications. As a member of SMPA, all you have to do is log in to SmartHub and sign up under "Notifications."
